

FAQ's for Parking Citations:

- **Where can I go to pay the parking ticket?**

You may either pay the parking citation via U.S. Mail using the envelope with the proper postage affixed to the outside, or bring it to the Hayward City Clerk's office located at 15889 W Third Street, in Hayward, Monday through Friday, 8:00 am – 4:00 pm.

- **What happens if I don't pay the ticket within 15 days?**

An additional ten dollar (\$10.00) late fee will be added to the original fine of \$25.00. If the fine is not paid within 30 days, notice of the violation will be sent to the Wisconsin Department of Motor Vehicles for registration suspension and/or refusal until the citation and applicable fees are paid.

- **How do I contest a citation?**

You may call the Hayward Police Department at (715)634-8961, and request a court date for the citation. A court date will be assigned to you with the Sawyer County Clerk of Courts office.

NOTE: If the citation is contested and you are found guilty, you will be responsible for applicable court costs and fees.
