

ORDINANCE NO. 552

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE CODE OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD, CHAPTER 428, ENTITLED “VEHICLES, ALL-TERRAIN,”

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Hayward, as follows:

Section 1. Section 428-3 of Chapter 428, Vehicles, All-Terrain, of the Code of the City of Hayward, is hereby amended to change the designated routes, to read as follows:

§ 428-3. Routes.

- A. A person may operate an ATV or UTV on any street, alley, parking lot, or land held open to the public within the City of Hayward.
- B. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. Sec. 23.33(11)(am)(4), ATVs/UTVs are authorized to operate on the following highways where the posted speed limit is 35 MPH or less:
 - (1) STH 27 from USH 63 south to South Florida Avenue.
 - (2) STH 27/77 from USH 63 northwesterly to Hospital Road
 - (3) STH 77 from USH 63 southeasterly to the intersection of Ranch Road and Lakewood Drive.
 - (4) County Highway B from STH 27 east to Chippewa Trail.
- C. ATV's / UTV's may not be operated on the following highway until designated by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.
 - (1) USH 63 from Greenwood Lane northwesterly to Hospital Road.

Section 2. Chapter 428 of the Code of the City of Hayward is hereby amended to add a new section following § 428-4, to be known as § 428-4.1 as follows:

§ 428-4.1. Disturbing the peace and nuisance activities.

- A. Cruising prohibited. No person shall, while operating an ATV or UTV, engage in the practice of cruising on any authorized street or alley. Cruising is defined as running all or part of the length of a road or alleyway multiple times, per day, back and forth, for any purpose other than departing or arriving at their residence or place of lodging.
- B. Exhaust system / muffler modifications prohibited. No person shall operate on a City route any ATV/UTV unless such ATV/UTV is equipped with an adequate muffler in constant operation and properly maintained to prevent any excessive or unusual noise or annoying smoke.
- C. Radios or electronic sound amplification devices. No person may operate or park, stop or leave standing an ATV / UTV vehicle while using a radio or other electronic sound amplification device emitting sound from the vehicle that exceeds the limits set forth in the Code of the City of Hayward per Chapter 333, Article VIII, Noise.

Section 3. Effective date.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
