**NOTICE - CITY OF HAYWARD RESIDENTS  
CITY CLEAN UP**

The City of Hayward will be doing its fall pick up of leaves, pine needles, brush, etc. in the near future. All residents are directed to have their debris out on the curb or in the alley at the edge of their property by **Monday, October 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020**. City crews **will pick up only once**. If your debris is not ready when the trucks are in your neighborhood, you will have to hold the debris over until spring.

The City **will only pick up** leaves, pine needles, lawn clippings and brush. Leaves, needles and lawn clippings must be piled separately from brush. **DO NOT** bag or put leaves, etc. in containers. Brush must be kept separate and stacked orderly - 8' maximum length. Tree limbs from trees that have been trimmed will be allowed. However, entire trees taken down are the responsibility of the property owner. Stumps, garbage, trash and/or building & remodeling debris **will not** be accepted. You must make your own arrangements to dispose of these items. Any piles not in compliance with the above will not be picked up.

**Please note:** RESIDENTS ARE ASKED TO SEPARATE BRUSH FROM LEAVES & LAWN CLIPPINGS, HOWEVER ONLY ONE PILE OF EACH WILL BE ALLOWED PER RESIDENCE. CITY CREWS WILL NOT PICK UP A BUNCH OF SMALL PILES ON THE PROPERTY.

City of Hayward residents can also drop off leaves, pine needles, lawn clippings and brush at any time throughout the year at the City of Hayward Garage, located at 10395 Vermont Avenue. Any questions should be directed to the Public Works Department at 715-634-4612.
