ARTICLE I

Temporary Parking Restrictions [Adopted 7-8-2002 by Ord. No. 418]

§ 325-1. Parking restrictions during construction or for special events.

Upon the recommendation of the full Common Council, the Chief of Police, and/or the City Public Works Director, it is hereby allowed to restrict parking on any street or highway within the City of Hayward due to construction or for special event purposes.

§ 325-2. Signage.

The streets affected shall be properly signed.

§ 325-3. Violations and penalties.

Violation of this article shall result in the forfeiture schedule as stated in Chapter 1, Article II, General Forfeiture, of the Code of the City of Hayward.

ARTICLE II
Parking Regulations

§ 325-4. Parking statutes incorporated by reference.

All Wisconsin Statutes, and amendments thereto, relating to parking are incorporated herein by reference.

§ 325-5. No parking at any time.

There shall be no parking on the following streets or highways at any time:

Dakota Avenue [Added at time of adoption of Code (see Ch. 1, General Provisions, Art. D)]	Northeast	From West Second Street northwest for a distance of 50 feet (loading zone only)
Dakota Avenue [Added at time of adoption of Code (see Ch. 1, General Provisions, Art. D)]	Northeast	From West Second Street southeast for a distance of 50 feet
Davis Street [Added at time of adoption of Code (see Ch. 1, General Provisions, Art. D)]	Northeast	From Railroad Street southeast for a distance of 215 feet
Railroad Street	Both	Entire length
State Trunk Highway 63	Both	Entire length
State Trunk Highway 77	Both	Entire length
State Trunk Highway 27	Both	Entire length
West Third Street	Both	From Dakota Avenue west for 1/2 block

§ 325-6. No parking between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. [Amended 5-9-2005 by Ord. No. 446; 11-14-2007 by Ord. No. 479]

There shall be no parking between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on the following streets within the City of Hayward:

Dakota Avenue	Both	From Highway 63 to Fifth Street

Name of Street	Side	Location
Fifth Street	Both	From Wisconsin Avenue to California Avenue, except for those designated parking spaces located along the southeast side of Fifth Street, between Main Street and Kansas Avenue
Fourth Street	Both	From Dakota Avenue to Kansas Avenue
Kansas Avenue	Both	From U.S. Highway 63 to Fifth Street
Main Street	Both	From Railroad Street to Fifth Street
Second Street	Both	From Wisconsin Avenue to California Avenue
Third Street	Both	From Wisconsin Avenue to Kansas Avenue

§ 325-7. Alternate side parking during winter months.

- A. Parking of motor vehicles on the streets within the City of Hayward from the first day of November of each and every year to the 15th day of April of the subsequent year shall be allowed only on the odd-numbered side of the street on odd-numbered days and on the even-numbered side of the street on the even-numbered days, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- B. Section 325-7A shall not apply to the streets and highways listed in §§ 325-5 and 325-6 above.

§ 325-8. Reserved parking areas.

Parking shall be allowed on a twenty-four-hour basis on the south side of East Fourth Street from the alley which connects East Third Street to East Fourth Street, easterly to Kansas Avenue. Said parking shall be limited to the owners and/or occupants of properties located at 10615 Kansas Avenue and 15855 Fourth Street.

§ 325-9. Parking time limited in municipal lots.

Parking on all municipal lots shall be for no more than 24 hours at any one time.

§ 325-10. Temporary parking regulations.

The Common Council, the Public Works Department and/or Police Department of the City of Hayward may prohibit, limit or allow parking on City streets on a case-by-case basis. In the event parking is limited or prohibited on a case-by-case basis, temporary signs shall be placed prior to enforcement.

§ 325-11. Enforcement for private parking lots.

All private parking lots which are appropriately signed, designating parking hours and permitted users, may be enforced by the City of Hayward.

§ 325-12. Parking near intersections.

There shall be no parking on either side of any street, within 30 feet of the right-of-way of the intersecting streets within the City of Hayward, except for those streets which have marked parking spaces as established by the City of Hayward Public Works Department.

§ 325-13. Handicap parking.

Parking at all marked and signed handicap stall/areas shall be limited to those vehicles which display the appropriate handicapped sign or sticker.

§ 325-14. Parking near mailboxes.

All vehicles shall be parked at least 15 feet from any mailbox.

§ 325-15. Time limit parking.

No person shall park a vehicle or allow the same to remain parked upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in this section, between the hours specified, for longer than the time indicated below:

§ 325-16. Violations and penalties.

- A. The forfeitures for a violation of this article are as follows: \$25, plus applicable court costs and all costs of prosecution of the offense.
- B. The forfeiture for any violation of a handicapped zone shall be \$100, plus applicable court costs and all costs of prosecution of the offense.
- C. Any amendments to the forfeiture schedule for violation of this article may be established by a resolution adopted by a majority vote of the Common Council of the City of Hayward.
