The meeting was called to order by Mayor Munich at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Munich thanked the Hayward Hospital staff for picking up garbage at various locations throughout the City on April 22nd – Earth Day.

Business Improvement District – Request to Close 2nd Street from Main Street to Alley (toward Dakota Avenue) on Saturday, May 29th

A motion was made by Ald. Gillis, seconded by Ald. Kennell to approve the requests, as presented by Billie Jo Sabin on behalf of the Hayward Business Improvement District, to close Second Street from Main Street to the Alley (toward Dakota Avenue) from 2:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 29th to allow space for bands to setup & play music and to showcase the recently installed mural. Lumberjack World Championships – An update regarding and requests for the 61st event

A motion was made by Ald. Williamson, seconded by Ald. Kreyer to approve the requests, as presented by Kristy Maki on behalf of the 61st Annual Lumberjack World Championships event to include parking on the City owned triangular piece of property located at the corner of Hall of Fame Drive & Lake Drive; temporary handicap parking on the pedestrian/bike trail by the main gate entrance; placing a banner across Main Street; and run/walk route with police escort at intersections. Clerk’s Report

A picnic license was issued to the Hayward Lakes Visitor & Convention Bureau for the Governor’s Fishing Opener & Expo on April 30, 2021.

Perpetual Care Certificate of Deposit (1300230276) in the amount of \$89,900 at Frandsen Bank & Trust matured on April 20th; \$1,450 from grave sales was added to the COD; the COD was renewed for an amount of \$91,350 for a period of 12 months at a rate of 0.15 percent.
