RESOLUTION NO. 22-06

COMPLIANCE MAINTENANCE ANNUAL REPORT

Be it hereby resolved that the City of Hayward informs the Department of Natural Resources that the following actions have been set forth by the City of Hayward Common Council:

1. Review of the 2021 Compliance Maintenance Annual Report (CMAR).
2. Address the groundwater quality issue by:
  - A. Pursuing advanced nitrogen treatment and nitrogen reduction options prior to the next wastewater treatment plant upgrade.
  - B. Continuing to sample groundwater from various monitoring wells and analyzing the samples on a quarterly basis.

**A motion was made by Ald. Miller, seconded by Ald. Williamson to approve the following:**

  - A. The hiring of Ryan Krummel, effective June 23, 2022, to fill the full time officer position vacated by Officer Marucha.
3. **From Public Works of 06/13:**
  - A. Awarding the bid for the paving (only) of Bay Avenue & Wheeler Street to Monarch Paving Company in the amount of \$68,963.10; and to award the bid for pulverizing (only) of Bay Avenue & Wheeler Street to A-1 Excavating Inc. in the amount of \$3,000.
  - B.&C. Moving forward with the purchase of the 2006 Jet Vac truck from Envirotech Equipment for an amount of \$86,900 and the sale of the 1995 Vac truck for \$30,000; provided the sale of the 1995 Vac truck and the purchase of the 2006 Vac truck coincide.

- D. Information Only. Construction plans have been drafted for the proposed 30'x30' pavilion / warming house to be located at the Tot Lot. Half of the structure will be enclosed, while the other half will be an open pavilion. The mayor stated that thanks to many generous donations, it appears the proposed improvements at the Tot Lot will be completed for little or no cost to the City.
- E. The purchase of a Twenty-six Activity Playset from Mendards for a cost not to exceed \$5,600; the playset to be installed at the Tot Lot.
- F. Allowing Sawyer County to install the necessary equipment and the link needed to provide Wifi at the City Beach; the only cost to the City will be for electricity (estimated at \$11 per year) to run the Wifi equipment.
