Review of the Main Street Reconstruction Project

Mike Stoffel, Ayres Associates Inc., informed those in attendance that the purpose of the meeting was to review the Main Street Reconstruction Project and to hear public comments and concerns regarding the Main Street Reconstruction Project or any other infrastructure or housing improvement project needs the public deems important. In addition to the CDBG funds, the City set aside funds in a capital projects account to help pay for the City's matching funds portion of the project costs. Reserve Water & Sewer funds were also utilized to help pay for the water & sewer portion of the project costs not covered by the CDBG funds.
