A motion was made by Ald. Hand, seconded by Ald. Miller to approve the hiring of Sean Caron to fill a vacant full time officer position, effective January 1, 2024. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ald. Williamson, seconded by Ald. Kreyer to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 5:50 p.m.
