2025 City of Hayward Budget

Budget Hearing – 2025 City of Hayward Budget

A public hearing was held regarding the 2025 City of Hayward Budget. The overall 2025 City of Hayward budget amount (\$2,279,013) increased \$89,777 over the 2024 budget amount (\$2,189,236). The proposed 2024 tax levy amount was listed at \$1,344,163: a decrease of \$6,497 levied for taxes for 2023.

The principal and interest payments budgeted for 2025 will be for payment on the 2nd Street reconstruction project loan. Clerk Poppe stated that these figures are only estimates at this time, as the 2nd Street reconstruction project has not been finalized.
